

PADI DEEP DIVER COURSE \$649

The lure of the deep. There's something exciting and mysterious about exploring deeper dive sites while scuba diving. Sometimes it's a wreck that attracts you below 18 metres/60 feet, and on wall dives it may be a giant fan or sponge. Whatever it is, to scuba dive with confidence at depths down to 40 metres/130 feet, you should take the PADI Deep Diver Specialty course.

If you've earned the PADI Deep Adventure Diver rating or higher, and you're at least 15 years old, you can enroll in the Deep Diver course.




WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Course structure, equipment requirements, digital paperwork and continuing education.





DIGITAL PAPERWORK



There are three documents that must be completed prior to the course

- 10346 Diver Medical Questionnaire
- 10060 Standard Safe Diving Practices Statement of Understanding
- 10072 Liability Release and Assumption of Risk Agreement

These forms are sent out with your eLearning and are accessed via your digital forms online. If you have any issues accessing it, please contact us.

DIVE MEDICAL - DO I NEED ONE?

Please work through the dive medical questionnaire carefully to determine whether you will require a dive medical or not as soon as possible. Any positive responses to the questions will require you to obtain a dive medical. If you require a dive medical, you will need to book an appointment with a dive doctor or GP before the start of the course. Please contact us for further information.

If you are aged over 40 a dive medical is highly recommended





PADI eLEARNING

Complete the Deep Diver eLearning content before any in-water training at your own pace whenever, wherever it's convenient for you. All eLearning content needs to be successfully completed.

Connect with your instructor whenever you have a question.

PRACTICAL TRAINING

The **4 boat dives** will be conducted **over 2 days** out of Eaglehawk Dive Centre **on the Tasman Peninsula**, home to some of the best dive sites in Tasmania including the SS Nord shipwreck and Cathedral Caves.

We will meet at the dive centre at **8am on the Saturday** with all SCUBA equipment.





The planned dives are as follows (subject to weather):

Saturday

- Deep Glen Bay (21m)
- The Sisters (35m)

Sunday

- The Nord (40m)
- Cathedral Caves (21m)





DIVE EQUIPMENT

You will need to provide and transport your own SCUBA equipment. Basic rental equipment is available for \$75.00 if required.

Dive cylinders and weights will be provided for the duration of the course.

You will need to provide your own

- SMB with reel
- Personal dive computer
- Primary dive light
- Back-up torch (recommended)

All available to buy in store.







Please note:

We do not include accommodation as part of the course.

Eaglehawk Dive Centre offers budget dorm accommodation from \$30/night. If you wish to use this, please book directly with them.

There is also the Lufra Hotel & other accommodation options available on the Tasman Peninsula.





WHAT WILL YOUR NEXT DIVE ADVENTURE BE?

The **PADI Rescue Diver Course** will teach you exactly that through rescue training exercises and open water scenarios that help you how to recognize diver emergencies.
